

ST. PETER'S CHURCH, BENTLEY - MEMORIAL INSCRIPTIONS.

Stained Glass windows:-

To the glory of God and in memory of WILLIAM COCKIN 1834-1906 and his wife HARRIET COCKIN 1845-1916 benefactors of this Church.

In memory of ROBERT COCKIN 1878-1929 and his wife RUTH CAROLINE MARIA COCKIN 1880-1964 Given by their SONS and DAUGHTERS

Below window with St. Peter - small brass:-

The Bells of this Church were returned JULY 1960
The gift of PERCY ELTON A Bellringer

Under second from front window RHS (facing altar) - Brass:-

To the Glory of God and in Memory of JAMES ATKINSON-JOWETT, LIEUT. 6th Battalion K.O.Y.L.I. Son of the late NATHAN ATKINSON-JOWETT Esq. and Mrs F. ATKINSON-JOWETT of CLOCKHOUSE, Manningham, Bradford and Rostholme, Bentley. Reported killed 16th September 1916 at GEUDECOURT FRANCE "He was as good as he was brave"

Under second from front window LHS (facing altar) - Brass:-

To the Glory of God and in memory of JOSHUA BROUGHTON. Born April 16th 1844. Died August 19th 1900 and the BROUGHTON family resident in the neighbourhood for 300 years This brass and also the CLOCK in the TOWER were given by ELIZA BROUGHTON widow of the above 1902

Lectern - Inscription round the bottom:-

WILLIAM HATCH Born 15th May 1821 Died 17th November 1888

Brass plaque behind Choir stalls RHS of Chancel:-

In Honoured Memory of WILLIAM COULTHREAD For twenty years a chorister of this Church Who suddenly passed away in choir standing his post on Sunday September 10th 1922 Aged 71
The souls of the righteous are in the hands of God
This brass is erected by his friends

Large brass to left of Altar:-

In loving memory of Charles Edward Stephen Cooke who erected this Church of St. Peter and dedicated it to the Glory of God as a memorial to his parents on the feast of St. Peter Mclcccxcii and who entered into Rest on the Feast of Simon and Jude October Mclcccxcu
Finish thy work then rest
Till then rest never
The rest prepared for thee by God
Is rest forever

Brass below dedication brass:-

In Loving Memory of Mary Louisa Wife of Charles Edward Stephen Cooke and daughter of Randolph 9th Earl of Galloway A great Benefactress to this Church Born 14th November 1842 Died 23rd February 1929
The souls of the righteous are in the hands of God - RIP
Erected by her nephews and nieces

FONT - under the centre window at the back of the Nave - the inscription round the wooden cover:-

To the Glory of God and in Memory of George William Tuplin Born 10th May 1867
Died 6 June 1945 This Font cover is the Gift of his Widow
