Has several databases of various indexes which are available as a search & print service for a small charge.

Those available at present are:-

1891 Census - for all parishes within the Archdeaconry of Doncaster.

1851 Census - A master index of all names, ages and occupations from the 86 parishes which are printed by DDFHS.

1871 Census - for all parishes covered by the Society.

Monumental Inscriptions from Hyde Park Cemetery (the largest cemetery within the Archdeaconry of Doncaster)

Monumental Inscriptions from Bawtry Cemetery

Burial Index - entries taken from the registers of parishes covered by the Society from 1538 to at least 1900.

Death Registers of Doncaster Health Authority complete from 1875 - 1927 and some entries from 1933.

Vital Records Index for British Isles of over five million baptisms and marriages, taken from records dating from 1538 to 1888.

Marriages are also held by Mrs L. Peabody. Many of them from the commencement of the parish registers to 1837.
