Transcript of the entry
SNAITH

SNAITH is a small market town and township, in the parish of its own name, and in the lower division of the Wapentake of Osgoldcross, seated in a champaign but fertile district, near the Knottingley and Goole canal, and on the south bank of the river Aire, 5 miles above its confluence with the Ouse, 7 miles from Selby and Thorne, 8 miles W.S.W. of Howden, and 175 miles N.N.W. of London. The *market* is held every Thursday, and the *fairs* for cattle, &c. on the last Thursday in April and on August 10th. The town has only 885 inhabitants, and its *history* will be given with the rest of its extensive parish, in Vol.11. the *Post Office* is at Mr. John Curtis's. Letters are despatched to the South, &c. at ½ past 7 morning, and to the North at 2 afternoon.
