

TICKHILL

MONUMENTAL INSCRIPTIONS

Because these inscriptions were covered by seats and flooring they were not included in the original transcription which was published on microfiche in 1982 by D & D FHS

Note: These inscriptions were found in the back of the burial register A56/1/A3. There is no indication of the writer or year.

A copy of the gravestones = inscriptions on the flags in Tickhill church now partially or wholly covered by the new seats and flooring.

1) Here lieth the body of Grace, the wife of Francis Staveley of Tickhill who died the 13th may 1772 aged 65 years.

2) Also Francis Staveley, their son. He died 27th September 1772 aged 47 years.

In the North Aisle

3) In memory of John Staveley who died January 25th 1797 age 34 years.

In the North Aisle

4) Thomas Tofield, armiger 1747

5) Elizabeth his wife 1770

In the Middle Aisle

6) In memory of Lieu't William Skelton '2nd West Yorks Reg't of militia' died 24 May 1818, age 43 years.

In the Middle Aisle

7) Here lieth the body of Mary the wife of John (space) who departed this life 11th day of July Anno Dom' 1682

In the Middle Aisle

8) Sacred to the memory of Thomas Robinson, Gentleman, who died January 16th 1823 aged 72.

9) Also Sarah, wife of the above Thomas Robinson who departed this life April 23rd 1831 aged 81.

In the South Aisle towards the North Side of it. (21ft from S. Door 13.6 from S. Wall)

10) The Rev. John Elam. He was the vicar of this parish (space) years, died April 29th 1774, age 70 years. Elizabeth his wife, died March 12th 1813 age 90

In the South Aisle towards the North side of it. 29ft from South Door. 14.8 from S. Wall

11) Sacred to the memory of I.S. Fisher whose remains were interred March 11th 1814.

In the South Aisle towards the South of it. 29ft from South Door. 9.8 from South Wall.

12) Here lieth the body of John Fisher Surgeon who departed this life the 27th day of January aged 31 years.

13) Also of Elizabeth his wife who died May 11th 1818 age 68 years.

In the South Aisle to the North Side of it. 35ft from South Door. 13ft from South Wall.

14) Here lieth the body of Mary, the wife of Mr Thomas Sissons, mercer, who departed this life the 28th day of November 1786, in the 74 year of her age.

- 15) Also lieth the body of Mr Thomas Sissons, mercer, who departed this life the 20th day of November 1788 aged 70 years.

In the South Aisle towards the South of it. 35ft from South Door. 9.6 from South Wall.

- 16) Here lieth the body of thomas Justice, his age 66, who departed this life the 21st day of June An. Dom. 1612

In the South Aisle. 13ft from South Wall. 15 ft from Sacrarium Screen.

- 17) In memory of James Orridge, late of brace-hill departed this life 20 July 1813 aged 67.

In the Sacrarium - Higher Part. 8ft 5 ins from East Wall. 8ft 9ins from South Wall.

- 18) Thomas Alderson - Obiit 28 March 1806 at 60.

In the Sacrarium - Higher Part. 9ft 9 ins from East Wall. 4ft from South Wall.

- 19) Christopher Alderson who died August 1st 1814.

10ft 3ins from East Wall. 5.3 from South Wall

- 20) Sacred to the memory of Mrs Elizabeth Alderson, wife of Christopher Alderson, of Tickhill Gentleman, she died May 10 A.D. 1801

From East Wall 12ft. South Wall 7ft

- 21) Hic Jacet Johannes, Sandford Armiger, Qui Orbit Monis Septembris, Anno Domi - - - -

In the Middle or Centre Aisle - North Side

- 22) Here lieth the body of Paul Hackett, who departed this life February 10th 1761, aged 61: - Also Richard Hackett, son of the above: who departed this life October 11th 1813 aged 77 years.

Here lieth the body of Mary, the wife of Paul Hackett, departed this life April 24 1756 aged 39 years.

- 23) Also Sarah Hackett, wife of the above Richard Hackett, departed this life May 16th 1823 aged 78 years.

- 24) Here lieth interred the body of Elizabeth, the wife of William Booker who departed this life - -the 25th 1765 aged - - years

On a small brass plate affixed to the same slab

- 25) Here lieth the body of Elizabeth, the wife of William Booker who departed this life October 25th 1775 aged 57 years.

In the South Aisle. From South Door 4ft 6ins, South Wall 14ft 6ins 25(sic)

Here lies interred the body of Richard Stones who departed this life February the 27th 1783 aged 44 years.

From South Door 11ft 0ins, South Wall 14ft 0ins

- 26) In memory of Jonathan Skelton who died May 8th 1801 (or 48?) Also of Sarah his wife who died October 9th 178- aged 25. Also Elizabeth, daughter of Jonathan and Sarah Skelton who died June 9 1783 age 2-?

From South Wall 9.00 From Sacrar' Screen 8.00

- 27) In memory of John Stones who died 23rd August 1808 at 62.

- 28) Richard Stones. Died January 23rd 1766 aged 50.
Sarah Stones his wife died January 31st 1808 aged 88

On one flag in the centre of the Sacrarium Screen. S. W. Side

- 29) Here lieth interred the body of George Booker. He died January 21st 1765 aged 80 years.

Here lieth the body of Mary, the wife of George Booker who departed this life March the 10th 1766 aged 78 years.

- In the Sacrarium - from East Wall 12ft 0ins. South Wall 2ft 0ins.
- 30) Here lieth the body of Frances Gill the daughter and only child of Francis Gill of Tickhill Gentleman who died in the eighth year of her age upon the 21st day of February Anno Domini 1715.
- From East Wall 2ft 0ins. South Wall 9ft 0ins.
- 31) Here lieth the remains of Wilfred Fox surgeon who departed this life December 8th 1757 aged 30 years. Also of Elizabeth his wife, daughter of Thomas Moor Gentleman who departed this life April 18th 1782 age 55 years.
- This is a small brass plate affixed to no. 31
- 32) Here lieth the remains of Thomas Fox Gentleman who departed this life 11th February 1789 at 30.
- From South Wall 7.0. Sacrar'm Screen 6.6
- 33) Here lieth the body of William, the son of William Booker who departed this life the 25th January 1768 aged 5 years & eleven months.
- From East Wall 21ft 0ins. South Wall 9ft 0ins.
- 34) Here lieth the body of Mary, the wife of William Booker who departed this life November the 14th 1754 aged 33 years. Also here lieth the body of William Booker who departed this life August 21st 1768 aged 45 years.
- From Sacrar'm Screen 9ft 0ins. South Wall 9ft 0ins.
- 35) Here lieth the body of Ann, the wife of William Booker who died March the 25th 1761 aged 57 years.
Also here lieth the body of William Booker who died December 8 1763 aged 69 years.
- From South Wall 12ft 6ins. Sacrar'm Screen 9ft.0ins
- 36) Here lieth the body of Mary wife of William Booker who departed this life March 17 1728 at 24. Also here lieth the body of Richard the son of William Booker who died March the 20th 1747 aged 24 years.
- From Sacrar'm Screen 9ft 0ins. South Wall 15ft 6ins.
- 37) Here lieth the body of william Booker who died on the 12th day of May 1778 aged 34 years.
Also here lieth the remains of Elizabeth wilson who died 15 of July 1836 aged 75 years.
- From East Wall 21ft 0ins. South Wall 15ft 0ins.
- 38) Here lieth the body of John Slyman of Tickhill Friers Gent'm who departed this life the 16th day of July 1683 aged 63 years.
Here lieth the body of Mr James Hawsworth of Tickhill Friars who died the 8 July 1780 aged 60 years.
- From East Wall 21ft 0ins. South Wall 12ft 0ins.
- 39) Here lieth interred the body of Mr Timothy Hawsworth of Tickhill Fryers who died the 1 August 1746 aged 63.
Also Jane his wife who died 7 January 1758 age 76
- From East Wall 20ft 0ins. South Wall 19ft 6ins.
- 40) Here lieth the bodys of Ruth and Hannah the daughters of Richard and Mary Cornford of Tickhill. Ruth departed this life 12 June AD aged 4 years & 9 months. Mrs Mary Gibson 1778
