It lists: 66 households, with occupation of head of household; dwelling place; numbers of male and female children, servants and lodgers; in many cases, age of eldest (E) and youngest (Y) child, and the total number of males and females in each household.

Footnote (a) the letters 'frag.' appeared in this column - meaning not known

(b) although listed in the 'female child' column, 'niece, 20' was entered here.
